BILL SUMMARY

To require all state and federal historic documents be defined solely by the author’s terms and definitions documented at the time written in order to preserve accuracy and avoid revision.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE,

Section 1. The indigenous American version of the English language employed by our Founding Fathers in creating our original state and federal documents, is unique and distinct, as well as state and national history that is hereby legally preserved and protected from revision by this Act.

Section 2. Public use or employment of State and Federal historic documents must be defined in perpetuity using only the author’s American language definitions documented when written.

This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
